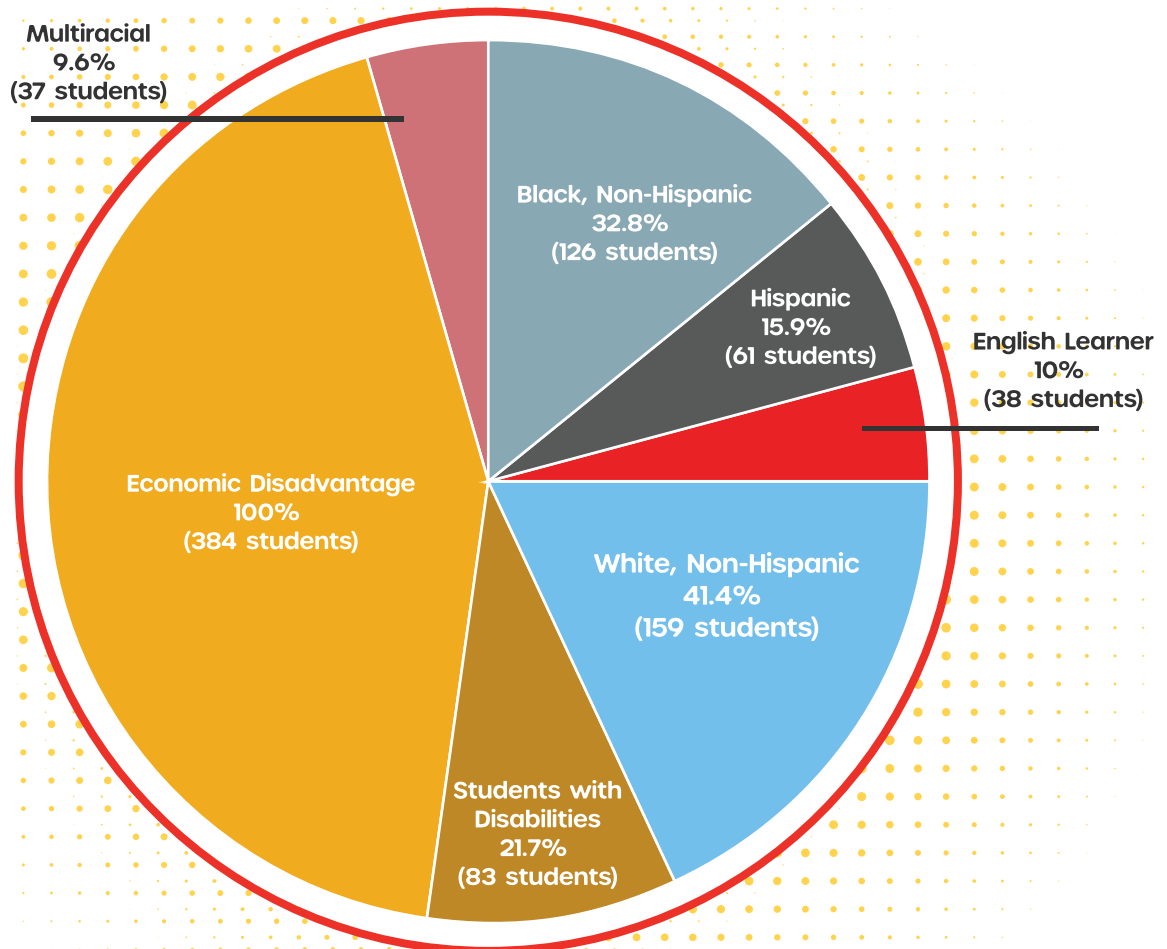

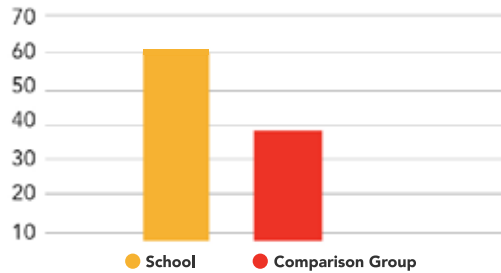

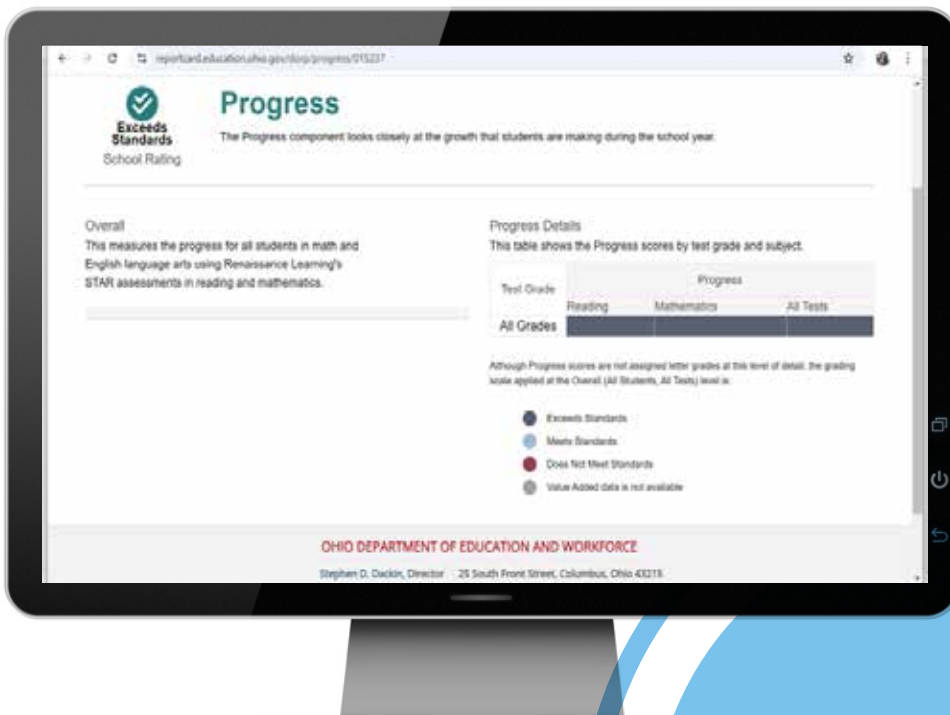
### How Does this School Compare to the Other Dropout Recovery Program Schools in Ohio?


