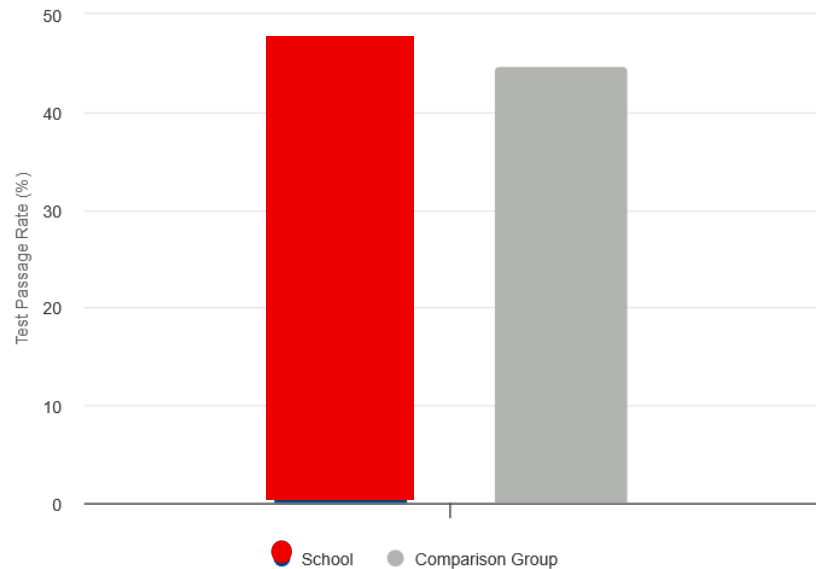

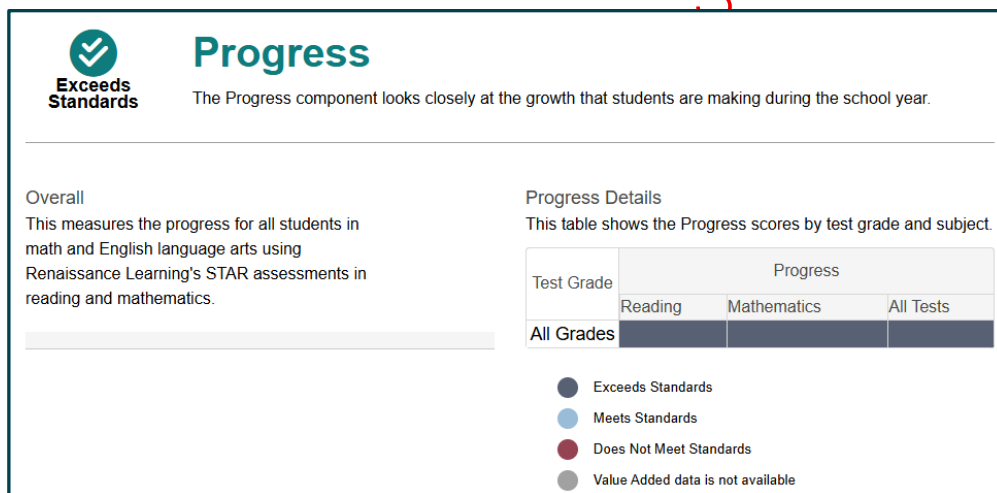

How Does this School Compare to the Other Dropout Recovery Program Schools in Ohio?

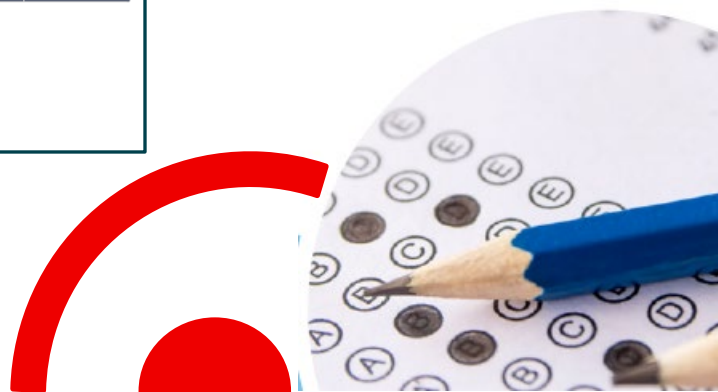

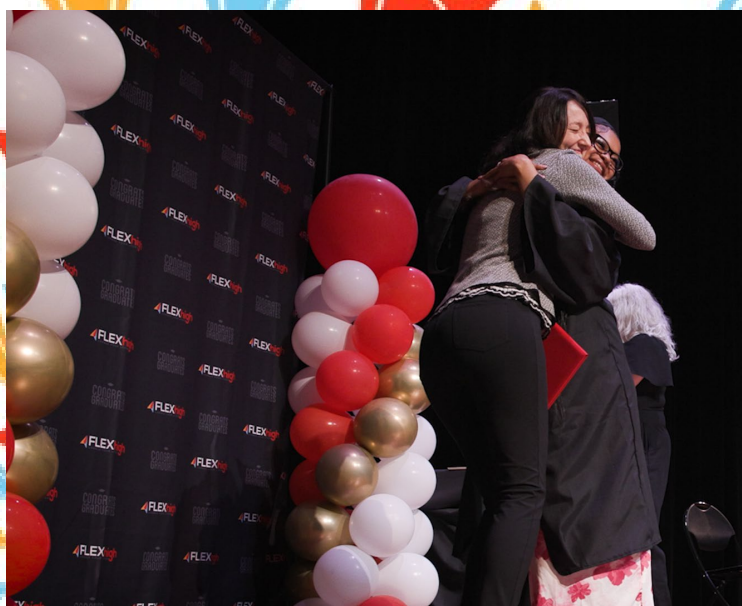


Flex **exceeds expectations** in the Progress rating with exceeds standards in both math and in reading using STAR assessments.
